Beginning with a humble setting in a government school building at Moti Bagh in 1964 with an enrolment of 300 students, the college shifted to its present location in 1989 and has now 3872 students on roll, representing all parts of India and abroad. Over the half a century, our students and faculty members have brought laurels to the institution by excelling in academics, sports, and cultural activities. There is hardly any faculty who has not represented the college in research at international level. Our alumni have also made us proud with their achievements in armed forces, administration, judiciary, entrepreneurship, creativity, and other areas.

This year too, the college has upheld its tradition of excellence in academic and extra-mural activities. Our students have done admirably well in examinations and some of them have even secured positions at the university level.

We have accomplished hundred percent results in most departments. I would urge you to have a look at the detailed results published at the end of this report.

We are privileged to have inspiring faculty members in our college. We are proud of our teachers who have made great contributions to the society in the form of social engineering. Besides imparting knowledge through their classes, our teachers also engage in research work and other activities that contribute to the university and our society. Currently, our faculty members are guiding Innovation projects funded by the University of Delhi. The achievements and contributions of our teachers are published in the later part of the report.

Our college conducts various academic and extra-academic activities through its Departmental Subject-Societies and Committees of staff council. Each of these societies and committees is run through active student participation under the esteemed leadership of our teachers. Most of these committees function through elected student bodies thereby providing them an opportunity to work in a team and also enhance their leadership capability in a democratic set up. This year also our college has witnessed several academic activities. Very recently, the Hindi Department of the college had organized one day International Seminar on "Hindi Katha Sahitya : Waishwik Paridrishya", which was well attended by the Eminent Scholars. Students and delegates from various colleges participated in the seminar. The English Department of the college had organised a 2 days National Seminar on "Censorship and Contemporary India; Histories, Texts and Contexts".

Diversity and Inclusiveness have always been vital and integral to evaluation for an academic institution. Motilal Nehru College also has proven its competence at par with this international criterion. At Motilal Nehru College we strive to uphold these modern values nurtured by classic principles. Our College also has an effectively run Student Aid Fund Committee that provides study materials, text books, and fee concessions to students coming from economically weak backgrounds. Our college also has an Internal Complaints Committee constituted as per The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013. We are committed to ensuring an environment that is free of all forms of sexual harassment. Upholding the University guidelines, Motilal Nehru College constituted an "Enabling Committee" for students seeking admission from SC, ST and OBC categories. Details of the activities of all the committees have been included in this report.

The college had introduced two skill development courses to impart skill based training to the final year students of the college from academic session 2016-17. The courses are being run by the college in collaboration with the National Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Government of India. The college had also applied to the National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development, which is an autonomous body under the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India.

Last but not the least we are collectively putting efforts so that this institution excels in all areas which would benefit our students and the society at large. I sincerely thank our chief guest Honorable Prof. C. S. Dubey Ji. I congratulate my fellow teachers and staff colleagues for organizing the Annual day function. आज के मुख्य अतिथि, श्री सी.एस. दुबे जी, अध्यक्ष, School of Open Learning, दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय और आज के सम्माननीय अतिथि, भूतपूर्व प्राधानाचार्य मोतीलाल नेहरू कॉलेज, डॉ. आर. एस. वत्स जी व मेरे सम्मानित सहकर्मियों और प्यारे विद्यार्थियों!

हमारा महाविद्यालय अपने विभागीय सब्जेक्ट सोसायटी और शैक्षिक परिषद् की समितियों द्वारा विभिन्न शैक्षिक एवं पाठ्यक्रमेतर गतिविधियों का आयोजन करता है। इनमें से प्रत्येक सोसायटी और समिति का संचालन विद्यार्थियों की सक्रिय भागीदारी और शिक्षकों के सम्मानित नेतृत्व के द्वारा होता है। अधिकतर समितियाँ विद्यार्थियों के निर्वाचित निकाय से संचालित होती हैं जिससे उन्हें एक समूह में काम करने के अवसर मिलते हैं और इससे एक लोकतांत्रिक व्यवस्था में उनकी नेतृत्व क्षमता का विकास भी होता है। इस वर्ष भी हमारे महाविद्यालय में कई शैक्षिक गतिविधियों का आयोजन हुआ है। अभी, हाल ही में, महाविद्यालय के हिंदी विभाग ने हिंदी कथा साहित्य : वैश्विक परिदृश्य विषय पर एक एक-दिवसीय अंतर्राष्ट्रीय संगोष्ठी का आयोजन किया जिसमें अच्छीखासी संख्या में प्रतिष्ठित विद्वानों ने भाग लिया। विभिन्न महाविद्यालयों से विद्यार्थियों और प्रतिनिधि



यों ने भी इसमें भागीदारी की। महाविद्यालय के अंग्रेजी विभाग ने भी एक दो-दिवसीय संगोष्ठी का आयोजन सेंसर और समकालीन भारत : इतिहास, पाठ, संदर्भ (CensorshipAnd Contemporary India : Histories, Texts, Contxts) विषय पर किया। साल भर, सब्जेक्ट सोसायटी और समितियों ने सम्मेलनों, बातचीत और उत्सवों का आयोजन किया। विविधता और समावेशन हमेशा ही किसी भी संस्था के मूल्यांकन के लिए आवश्यक और अभिन्न कसौटी रहे हैं। मोतीलाल नेहरु महाविद्यालय ने भी इन अंतर्राष्ट्रीय कसौटियों पर अपनी योग्यता प्रमाणित की है। मोतीलाल नेहरु महाविद्यालय में हम प्रतिष्ठित सिद्धांतों द्वारा पोषित आधुनिक मूल्यों को प्रोत्साहित करने में प्रयासरत रहते हैं। हम दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के उन पहले महाविद्यालयों में से एक हैं जिन्होंने विकलांगों के लिए अवरोध मुक्त कैंपस बनाया है। महाविद्यालय अपनी विविधता के लिए गौरवान्वित और सजग है तथा हमारे यहाँ विदेशी विद्यार्थियों और उत्तरपूर्व के विद्यार्थियों के लिए प्रकोष्ठ भी हैं। समावेशी भारत के प्रस्ताव को अभिव्यक्त करते हुए महाविद्यालय देश के समस्त प्रान्तों से विद्यार्थियों का स्वागत करता है।

हमारे महाविद्यालय में प्रभावी रूप से छात्र सहायता निधि समिति (StudentAid Fund Committee) भी संचालित है जो आर्थिक दृष्टि से कमजोर पृष्ठभूमि से आने वाले विद्यार्थियों को अध्ययन सामग्री, पाठ्य-पुस्तकें और शुल्क में छूट उपलब्ध कराती है। हमारे महाविद्यालय में कार्यस्थल पर स्त्री के लैंगिक उत्पीड़न (रोकथाम, निषेध और निवारण अधिनियम 2013) (The Sexual Harassment of WomenAt Workplace {Prevention, ProhibitionAnd RedressalAct, 2013}) के आधार पर एक आंतरिक शिकायत समिति (Internal Complaints Commitee) का गठन भी हुआ है। हम सभी प्रकार के यौन उत्पीड़न से मुक्त वातावरण सुनिश्चित करने के लिए प्रतिबद्ध हैं। विश्वविद्यालय के निर्देशों का अनुसरण करते हुए मोतीलाल नेहरु महाविद्यालय ने अनुसूचित जाति, अनुसूचित जनजाति और अन्य पिछड़ा वर्ग की श्रेणियों में प्रवेश लेने वाले विद्यार्थियों के लिए एक उत्तरदायी और निवारण करने वाली समर्थनकारी समिति (Enabling Commitee) का गठन किया है। सभी समितियों की गतिविधियों के विवरण इस रिपोर्ट में शामिल किये गए हैं।

अकादमिक सत्र 2016-2017 के अंतिम वर्ष के विद्यार्थियों को कौशल आधारित प्रशिक्षण देने के लिए महाविद्यालय ने दो कौशल विकास पाठ्यक्रम लागू किये। महाविद्यालय में ये पाठ्यक्रम राष्ट्रीय कौशल विकास एवं उद्यम, भारत सरकार के सहयोग से चलाये जा रहे हैं। महाविद्यालय ने उद्यम एवं लघु व्यापार विकास राष्ट्रीय संस्थान में भी आवेदन दिया है जो कौशल विकास और उद्यम मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के अंतर्गत एक स्वायत्त संस्था है।

अंत में एक महत्वपूर्ण बात यह कहना चाहता हूँ कि हम सब मिलकर प्रयासरत हैं कि यह संस्था सभी क्षेत्रों में उत्तम करे। मैं हार्दिक रूप से मुख्य अतिथि माननीय श्री सी.एस. दुबे जी के प्रति आभार व्यक्त करता हूँ। मैं इस वार्षिक दिवस का आयोजन करने के लिए अपने सह-अध्यापकों और सहकर्मियों को भी बधाई देता हूँ। इसके साथ ही मैं सभी विद्यार्थियों को भी बधाई देता हूँ और उनके मंगलमय भविष्य की कामना करता हूँ।

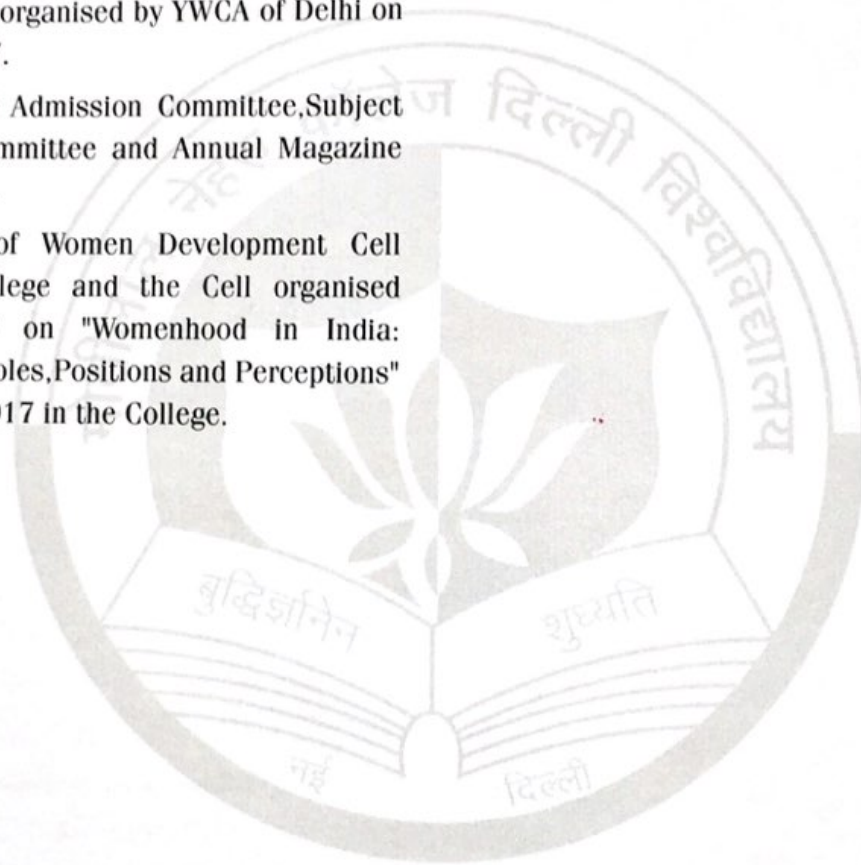
