The Placement Cell of Motilal Nehru College organises and prepares students for the final placements.

The objective of the college placement cell is to help students identify their career goals and provide an edge into the present day competitive job market. The same has been made possible through resume building workshops, on campus and off campus recruitment drives for the students.

The cell is composed of a dedicated team of students from a variety of courses, currently guided by Ms. Ekta Duggal as the convener and led by Gargi Kadyan and Roopala Saxena as Chief Coordinators.

This year, the first company to visit the college was KPMG. KPMG is a global network of independent member firms offering audit, tax and advisory services. The drive saw a huge student participation and twenty-five students from B.Com finally got recruited as Audit Associates.

It was followed by EY Global Delivery services, one of the largest professional services firms in



the world, which hired sixteen B.Com. Program and B.Com. (Hons.) students for the post of Assurance Associates.

Decathlon, one of the world's largest sporting goods manufacturer and retailer, hired fourteen students from a variety the courses as Sport Advisors/Leaders.

An off-campus drive was organised by Inshorts, a highly popular Digital News App through which 4 students of English Honours were recruited.
