The council approved minutes of emergent meetings dated 2nd Jan. 2018 and 14th March 2018.



Agenda item no. 2

Secretary informed staff council about correspondences made to DG-CSIR, UGC chairmen and PVC Delhi University for inviting as the chief guest for the Annual Day function. Secretary also invited suggestions from the house about chief guest. Council entrusted Principal and Secretary to organize Annual Day in coming two weeks.

Any other matter:

The members raised several issues and staff council took the following decisions:

- i) Issue of credit of earned leaves of teachers in lieu of working in vacations was raised. The chairman council took into notice and assured the members to do the needful.
- ii) Chairman, council placed the letter of Naveen Yadav about short-term language course (German and French) for students in vacation. Council entrusted the Chairman to look into the feasibility.
- iii) Issue of mathematics department demand was discussed and chairman ensured the department to provide Lab assistant after approval in Governing Body.
- iv) Issue of NCW was raised in council for better management and transparency. It was decided that teacher In-charge ship should be made tenure based i.e. for a period of 2 years only and Principal should invite application from the interested teachers in the spirit of equal opportunity.
- v) College should provide cubical rooms to NSS officer, PIO and other statutory officials. Secretary raised the need of personal cupboards to faculty members. It was decided that new cupboards for teachers be arrange at suitable place in college so that teachers may not face the problem in keeping the records.



Reporting items:


- Secretary reported the commencement of Motilal Nehru Lecture by Dr. S Y Quraishi, former CEC, India on 12th March 2018.
