An online meeting (recorded) of ICC was held on 10<sup>th</sup> DEC. 2021. Following members were present.

As decided in the meeting convened by ICC on 7<sup>th</sup> Dec., an online meeting was convened on wherein ICC heard the complaint.

During this time, the respondent, Sumit Yadav couldn't be contacted since there are more than one Sumit in B.A (P).

IIIrd yr. in the college. The complainant narrated the turn of events on.

Preliminary inquiry confirmed that an obscene message was indeed sent by the accused, Sumit Yadav to Rajshree Agarwal on the unofficial whatsapp group of B.A (Prog) MLNC <sup>on 18 Nov 2022</sup>. After hearing the complainant, the committee decided to convene another meeting first contact Sumit Yadav and then hold a meeting where both the sides would be heard.

An online meeting (recorded) of ICCC was held on 3<sup>rd</sup> Jan 2022 at 12:30 pm. - following members were present.

In continuation of the complaint filed by Ms. Rajshree Agarwal, another meeting was convened with the external expert, Mrs. (Dr.) Dr. (Mrs) Pawan Sharma also being present. The respondent Sumit Rao was heard first since Rajshree Agarwal's case previously been heard in the meeting conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> Dec 2021.

Sumit Rao maintained that he wasn't the one who had abused first and had attempted however he was not able to justify the specific message which is the basis of the complaint. This was followed by the committee hearing the complainant. She informed the committee about how she'd felt hurt and insulted after receiving the message (in unofficial WhatsApp group of MNC), and had confronted the respondent on personal chat and had even abused him. She also mentioned how the accused had tried to apologize to her but she cut the

call and his brother also trying to mediate between the two sides to resolve the conflict in an amicable manner.

Since the case has happened off-campus, in the online mode, the committee had informed the complainant of the two ways in which she could further pursue the complaint i.e. by either lodging a formal FIR with the cyber cell or continuing with the ICC complaint.

After hearing both sides, the committee members deliberated the future course of action. They concluded that the matter wasn't of much gravity and the need for the punishment to be proportionate to indiscretion committed. In the immediate term, it was decided that an email would be sent to Rajshree Agarwal asking her for a follow up regarding the manner in which she'd like to pursue the complaint. Sumit Rao was also asked to mail ICC his stand in writing.

However, a repeat of the offense would attract serious punishment.
