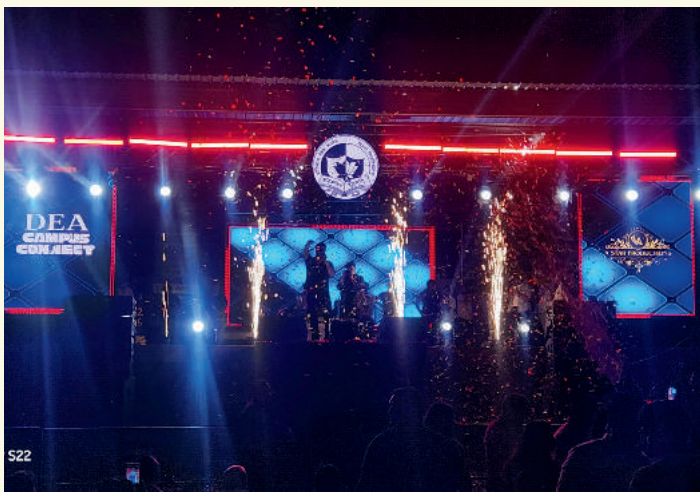

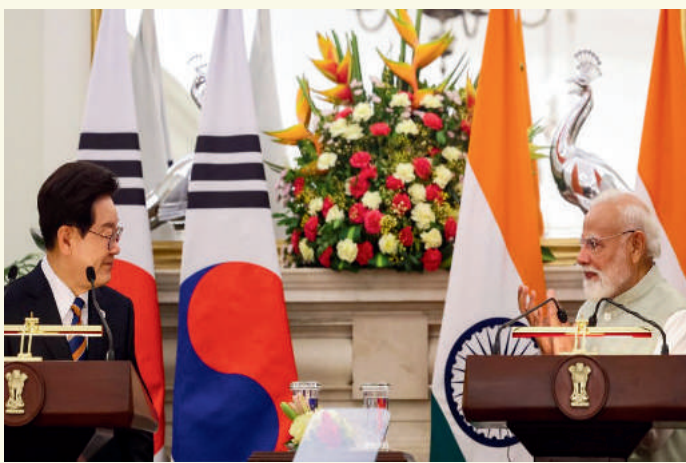

THE PACT FOCUSES ON DEFENSE TECHNOLOGY, SEMICONDUCTORS, AND GREEN HYDROGEN. A SIGNIFICANT OUTCOME WAS THE AGREEMENT FOR AN ANNUAL INDIA-ROK STEEL DIALOGUE TO STABILIZE SUPPLY CHAINS.

EXPANSION OF PMGSY-III TILL 2028

THE NEWS: THE UNION CABINET APPROVED THE EXTENSION OF THE PRADHAN MANTRI GRAM SADAK YOJANA - III (PMGSY-III) UNTIL MARCH 2028.

THE GOVERNMENT INCREASED THE BUDGET OUTLAY TO ₹83,977 CRORE. THIS EXTENSION AIMS TO FINISH 125,000 KM OF RURAL ROADS, CONNECTING REMOTE VILLAGES TO HOSPITALS, SCHOOLS, AND AGRICULTURAL MARKETS.

THE NEWS: THE CENTRAL ELECTRICITY AUTHORITY (CEA) ANNOUNCED AN AMBITIOUS TARGET TO INCREASE INDIA'S NUCLEAR POWER CAPACITY FROM 8.8 GW TO 100 GW BY 2047.

THIS MARKS A TENFOLD INCREASE AS PART OF INDIA'S "VIKSIT BHARAT" GOAL. THE PLAN INVOLVES THE RAPID DEPLOYMENT OF SMALL MODULAR REACTORS (SMRS) AND INDIGENOUS PRESSURIZED HEAVY-WATER REACTORS



INCOME TAX DEPARTMENT HOLDS AWARENESS PROGRAM ON THE NEW ACT, 2025

INCOME TAX ACT 2025 OUTREACH

THE NEWS: THE INCOME TAX DEPARTMENT LAUNCHED A NATIONWIDE OUTREACH PROGRAM TO EDUCATE TAXPAYERS ON THE FEATURES OF THE NEW INCOME TAX ACT, 2025.

THIS NEW ACT SIMPLIFIES THE TAX CODE, REMOVING SEVERAL COMPLEX EXEMPTIONS IN FAVOR OF LOWER SLABS, AIMING TO MAKE INDIA MORE BUSINESS-FRIENDLY AND TAX-COMPLIANT NATION.



DELIMITATION & WOMEN'S QUOTA ASSURANCE

THE NEWS: PM MODI ASSURED PARLIAMENT ON APRIL 16 THAT THE UPCOMING DELIMITATION EXERCISE (REDRAWING OF CONSTITUENCY BOUNDARIES) WILL NOT LEAD TO ANY STATE BEING DISCRIMINATED AGAINST.

THIS IS A CRUCIAL POLITICAL ISSUE AS SOUTHERN STATES FEARED LOSING LOK SABHA SEATS DUE TO SUCCESSFUL POPULATION CONTROL. THE DELIMITATION IS TIED TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE 33% WOMEN'S RESERVATION IN LEGISLATURES.

G20 TO HOLD URGENT TALKS ON WAR IMPACT ON GLOBAL FOOD AND FERTILIZER SUPPLY

THE G20 WILL CONVENE URGENT DISCUSSIONS AFTER THE UNITED STATES RAISED CONCERNS OVER SUPPLY DISRUPTIONS CAUSED BY THE ONGOING MIDDLE EAST CONFLICT. THE CRISIS HAS ALREADY IMPACTED KEY AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS, ESPECIALLY WHEAT AND FERTILIZERS. EXPERTS WARN THAT VULNERABLE NATIONS COULD FACE RISING FOOD PRICES AND SHORTAGES IF SUPPLY CHAINS REMAIN UNSTABLE.

RUN AWAY, PLEASE.

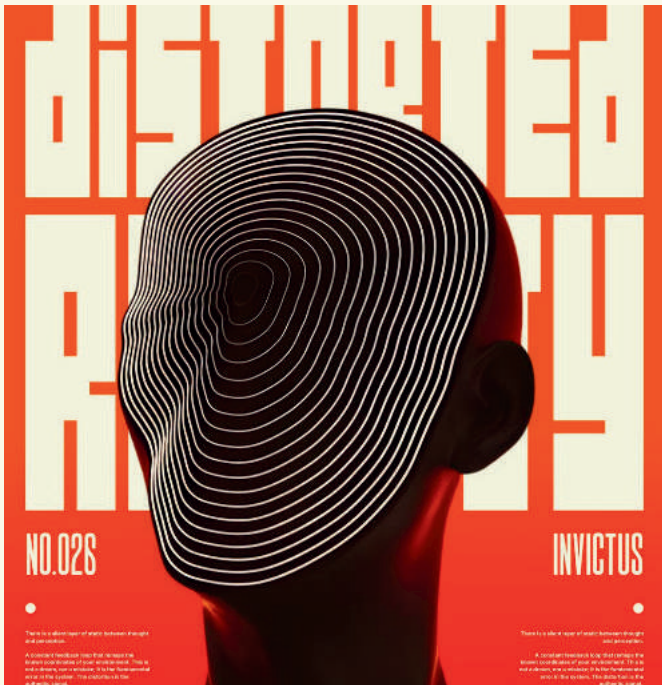

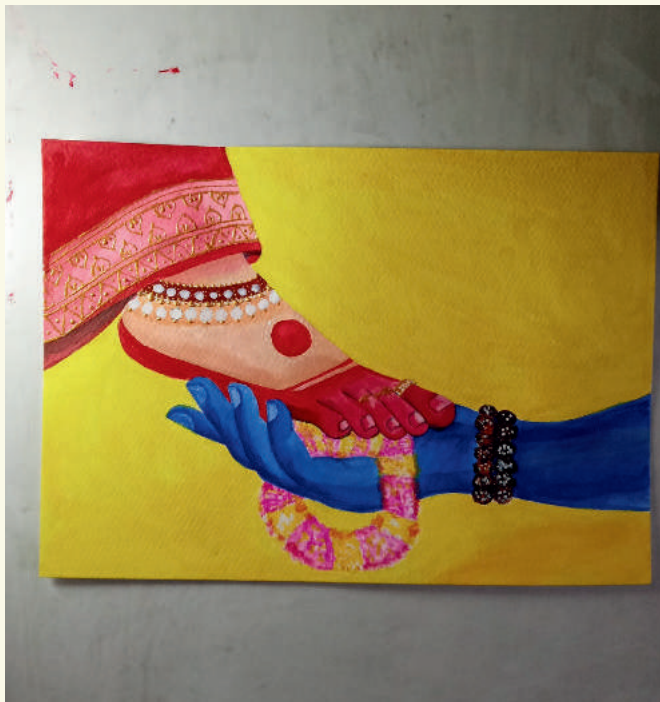
