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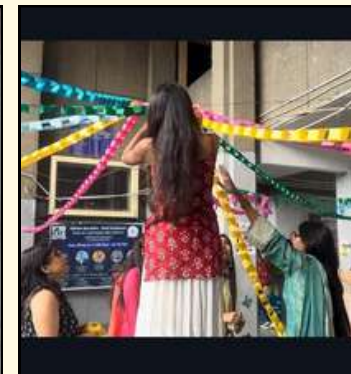

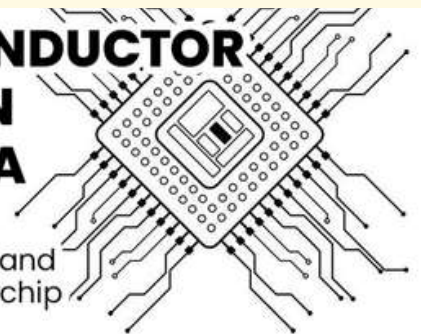

PHYSICS AROUND US IN DAILY LIFE

AS STUDENTS WE OFTEN THINK THAT PHYSICS IS LIMITED TO CLASSROOMS BUT, IN REALITY IT'S NOT ONLY ABOUT DIFFICULT FORMULAS, COMPLICATED CALCULATIONS, AND PROBLEMS IN TEXTBOOKS. BECAUSE OF THIS, PHYSICS SOMETIMES FEELS LIKE A SUBJECT THAT ONLY EXISTS IN CLASSROOMS OR LABORATORIES. IN REALITY, PHYSICS IS PRESENT ALL AROUND US IN OUR EVERYDAY LIFE. MANY SIMPLE ACTIVITIES THAT WE PERFORM DAILY ARE ACTUALLY EXAMPLES OF BASIC PHYSICS PRINCIPLES, EVEN THOUGH WE MAY NOT NOTICE THEM.

ONE COMMON EXAMPLE OF PHYSICS IN DAILY LIFE IS WALKING. WHEN WE WALK, WE PUSH THE GROUND BACKWARD WITH OUR FEET. ACCORDING TO NEWTON'S THIRD LAW OF MOTION, EVERY ACTION HAS AN EQUAL AND OPPOSITE REACTION. SO WHEN WE PUSH THE GROUND BACKWARD, THE GROUND PUSHES US FORWARD. THIS REACTION HELPS US MOVE AHEAD. WALKING MAY SEEM VERY SIMPLE, BUT IT IS ACTUALLY A PERFECT EXAMPLE OF PHYSICS IN ACTION.

ANOTHER EXAMPLE CAN BE SEEN WHEN WE RIDE A BICYCLE. WHILE RIDING, WE TRY TO MAINTAIN BALANCE SO THAT WE DO NOT FALL. THIS BALANCE DEPENDS ON FORCES SUCH AS GRAVITY AND FRICTION.

THE WHEELS OF THE BICYCLE KEEP MOVING DUE TO MOMENTUM, WHILE FRICTION BETWEEN THE TIRES AND THE ROAD PREVENTS SLIPPING. BECAUSE OF THESE PHYSICAL FORCES WORKING TOGETHER, WE ARE ABLE TO RIDE THE BICYCLE SMOOTHLY.

PHYSICS IS ALSO PRESENT IN MANY THINGS WE USE AT HOME. FOR EXAMPLE, A CEILING FAN WORKS WITH THE HELP OF AN ELECTRIC MOTOR. THE MOTOR CONVERTS ELECTRICAL ENERGY INTO MECHANICAL

ENERGY, WHICH MAKES THE BLADES ROTATE AND PRODUCE AIRFLOW. SIMILARLY, REFRIGERATORS WORK ON THE PRINCIPLE OF HEAT TRANSFER. THEY REMOVE HEAT FROM INSIDE THE FRIDGE AND RELEASE IT OUTSIDE, WHICH HELPS KEEP FOOD COOL AND FRESH.

COOKING IS ANOTHER ACTIVITY WHERE PHYSICS CAN BE OBSERVED. WHEN WE HEAT WATER ON A STOVE, HEAT ENERGY MOVES FROM THE FLAME TO THE VESSEL AND THEN TO THE WATER. AS THE TEMPERATURE INCREASES, THE WATER MOLECULES MOVE FASTER AND EVENTUALLY START BOILING. THIS SHOWS HOW HEAT TRANSFER AND CHANGES IN THE STATE OF MATTER OCCUR IN DAILY LIFE.

SPORTS ALSO INVOLVE MANY PHYSICS CONCEPTS. IN GAMES LIKE CRICKET OR FOOTBALL, THE MOVEMENT OF THE BALL DEPENDS ON FORCE, SPEED, AND DIRECTION. WHEN A PLAYER HITS OR KICKS THE BALL, THE FORCE APPLIED DETERMINES HOW FAR AND HOW FAST THE BALL WILL TRAVEL. ALTHOUGH PLAYERS MAY NOT THINK ABOUT THESE SCIENTIFIC IDEAS WHILE PLAYING, PHYSICS IS STILL WORKING BEHIND THE SCENES.

IN CONCLUSION, PHYSICS IS NOT JUST A SUBJECT IN BOOKS BUT A PART OF OUR EVERYDAY EXPERIENCES.

FROM WALKING AND CYCLING TO COOKING AND PLAYING SPORTS, MANY DAILY ACTIVITIES FOLLOW THE LAWS OF PHYSICS. BY OBSERVING OUR SURROUNDINGS MORE CAREFULLY, WE CAN UNDERSTAND THAT SCIENCE IS ALWAYS PRESENT IN THE SIMPLE THINGS WE DO EVERY DAY.

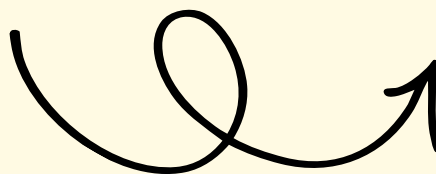
